Less than 200 people have successfully completed this feat, ever.

150 days of solo sailing are necessary to complete the world's circumnavigation. The Challenge starts in Spain, before traveling down South of the three iconic capes : the Cape of Good Hope, the Leeuwin Cape and the mythical Cape Horn.
